




ALL ROADS LEAD TO ŁÓDŹ. LOCATION


Łódź Fabryczna Railway Station, with EC1 in the background | © www.lodz.pl

A great advantage of Łódź is its central location. The city is situated both in the central part of Poland and of Europe, as a result of which "everything is close-by". A convenient location goes hand in hand with good communication – the agglomeration is surrounded by a number of highways and expressways which provide fast connections with cities in Poland and abroad.



ROADS

Not too far away from Łódź there is the intersection of two main highways: A1 and A2, which constitute part of the Trans-European Transport Network (TEN-T) that connects the Western and Eastern side of Europe, and the Baltic states with the southern part of the continent. Located on the south of the city, expressway S8, which connects Łódź and Wroclaw, is also of international significance. Another expressway is planned: S14, which will constitute the western section of the Łódź ring.





RAILWAY

Łódź offers good railway connections with all major cities in Poland. For example, it takes slightly more than one hour to get to Warsaw. The convenient connection to the capital city is a great advantage, especially considering the appeal of the city's office market. Łódź also offers a direct railway connection to Chengdu in China, which is a part of the New Silk Road. The transit of goods from Poland to China over a distance of 10,000 km takes on average between 12 and 14 days. For comparison, sea freight between Far East harbours and Europe takes around 45 days. As a result, railways and terminals located in the central part of Poland offer exceptional opportunities to Chinese enterprises which are interested in investing in Poland or in other European markets.



AIRPORTS

There are two airports nearby Łódź. From the city centre you can reach the Wladyslaw Reymont International Airport within 10 minutes by car. This airport deals with passenger and freight transportation. Meanwhile, 130 km further you'll find the largest airport in Poland – the Warsaw Chopin Airport, which offers flights to more than 100 destinations all around the world.



A distinctive feature of the city is its close location to the capital city of Poland – Warsaw, which has a positive impact on creating a business synergy between the two. The travelling time and communication between the cities is convenient enough to facilitate business and enables quick transport, even daily commuting.



It takes just 90 minutes to go from the centre of Łódź to the Chopin Airport in Warsaw, from which you have access to around 100 national and international destinations.

COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT!

About 100 km from Łódź a new Central Transportation Port is to be built. This main transportation centre will combine air, rail, and road traffic. According to the project, the airport will service 45 million passengers per year already after the first construction stage. The project design should be completed by the end of 2019, with the opening of the Port planned for 2027.

AND INSIDE THE CITY ITSELF...

Located in the city centre, Łódź Fabryczna Railway Station was recently subject to a complete renovation, becoming one of the most state-of-the--art transit centres in Europe.

COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT!

In tódź, there is currently a huge railway investment in progress. The tracks which go through the centre of tódź as well as platforms were moved underground due to the construction of a new cross-city tunnel under tódź Downtown. Thanks to the tunnel, tódź Fabryczna Railway Station will gain new connections, which will facilitate communication with other cities. There are also plans to build two additional underground stations. The new line going through the tunnel will be a sort of tódź underground. At present, tódź Fabryczna Railway Station offers access to many means of transport, both private and public, including trains, buses, trams, and city bikes.



BIKE – Located all around Łódź, city bikes are a quick and ecological means of transport in the city. You can quickly rent one via a convenient mobile app. At present, there are 1500 bikes and 148 stations in Łódź, and this number is growing.



SCOOTER – The city also offers nearly 50 scooters in the subscription system, either pre-paid or payable-byminute.



CAR – On the streets of Łódź, you can rent one of the 50 hybrid vehicles with automatic transmission.

INVEST IN ŁÓDŹ. KEY SECTORS. ECONOMY AND INDUSTRY



The development of the city is based on the Regional Development Strategy which aims at supporting innovation and enhancing cooperation and partnership between regional authorities and investors. The key sectors for the Łódzkie region are mainly involved in the modern textile and fashion industries, as well as advanced construction materials, IT, and telecommunications.

YOUTH IN ŁÓDŹ. EDUCATION

Łódź is one of the major academic centres in Poland. The city offers in total 19 institutions of higher education, 7 public and 12 non-public, as well as 30 R & D institutions. There are almost 72 thousand people studying at the universities in Łódź, including 5 thousand foreign students, with 20 thousand graduating each year.





THE UNIVERSITY OF ŁÓDŹ

is one of the leading institutions of higher education in Poland, with a total of 32 thousand students in its departments. The university offers 104 fields of study. The university cooperates with a number of foreign universities. Thanks to student exchange programs, the students of the University of Łódź can also continue their studies in 28 European countries.

THE ŁÓDŹ UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

has maintained top positions in rankings of technical universities for many years. It is the winner of the competition for the most innovative and creative university in Poland in providing occupational perspectives and one of the most willingly selected technical institutions. Graduates of the Łódź University of Technology enjoy the recognition of Polish and foreign employers.

THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY

educates doctors, dentists, pharmacists and medical service specialists, and is the only university in Poland to provide studies for medical officers of the military healthcare service in cooperation with the Ministry of National Defence. The Medical University in Łódź is ranked one of the leading institutions, and its teaching, research, and lab facilities are among the best equipped in Poland. is one of the oldest and most prestigious film schools in the world. It educates directors, cameramen, actors, animation artists, editors, producers, script writers and photographers. It is the alma mater of many outstanding film-makers, with graduates including: Andrzej Wajda, Roman Polański, Kazimierz Kutz, Jerzy Skolimowski, Zbigniew Rybczyński, Krzysztof Kieślowski, Filip Bajon, and Janusz Gajos.

WŁADYSŁAW STRZEMIŃSKI ACADEMY OF FINE ARTS

is a modern art college which, while keeping up with progress, has not forgotten the fact that modern art and design is founded in tradition. Established in 1945, the academy was intended for creative students looking for adventures in the world of fashion, as well as painting and graphics enthusiasts. The importance of the academy in the international arena is growing each year thanks to projects such as the international Young Textile Art Triennial (YTAT), the international Printing And Textile Art Courses (PATA), and the Łódź Young Fashion event.

GRAŻYNA AND KIEJSTUT BACEWICZ ACADEMY OF MUSIC IN ŁÓDŹ

is one of the leading art academies in Poland. It is open to new forms of developing passion and talent as well as promoting musical culture and education. Its rich didactic offer comprises over 50 specialisations in four departments.

"YOUTH IN ŁÓDŹ" PROGRAMME



The "Youth in Łódź" programme supports students in pursuing their professional career, encouraging them to bind their future with the city. At the same time, it supports local entrepreneurs and investors in obtaining highly qualified staff.

As many as 98% of Łódź students having heard of any campaign addressed to young people spontaneously point to the "Youth in Łódź" programme. Thanks to the programme, students can take advantage of a student discount card, take part in free training courses, gain experience during paid holiday internships, obtain scholarships, and meet employers in Łódź. The programme is conducted by the Economic Development and International Cooperation Bureau of the City of Łódź. Leading universities of Łódź and over 280 employers from the city and its region are partners of the programme.



SPECIALISED STAFF. EDUCATIONAL PROFILES.

EDUCATION WITH A VIEW OF EMPLOYMENT

The universities situated in Łódź care for the development of their students by offering studies and faculties that meet the labour market demand. As a result of the demand for top experts in many fields, both the University of Łódź and the Łódź University of Technology, in cooperation with entrepreneurs, offer an education that increases job opportunities among graduates in specific fields.





New courses of study have been established recently as an answer to the requirements of many companies, such as Agat, Astor, Comarch, Ericsson, and Fujitsu.

EXAMPLES OF STUDIES FOR THE BPO/SSC/IT SECTORS

The institutions of higher education located in Łódź offer, among others, studies for BPO/SSC/IT and production experts, whereas the content of studies is prepared in consultations with the CISCO academy and JUNIPER. Thanks to this, university graduates are highly qualified employees, ready to take up work in leading companies.






The New Centre of Łódź (NCŁ) is a modern area at the heart of the city combining business, cultural, commercial, and transportation functions. With work underway, an area of nearly 100 ha in the city centre is subject to wide-spread revitalisation. In the NCŁ area is situated, among others: the EC1 building, the new Łódź Fabryczna railway station, and modern office buildings. The NCŁ features the renovated building of the first power station in Łódź, EC1. The exceptional character of the place refers to the industrial past of the city. At present, EC1 performs cultural, artistic, and educational roles. At its heart is the largest Science and Technology Centre in Poland and a state-of-the-art planetarium. The EC1 complex is also the headquarters of institutions bringing together artists and film-makers – Łódź Film Commission and the Centre for Comics and Interactive Narration.





THE NEW CENTRE OF ŁÓDŹ



A major point in the New Centre of Łódź is the new underground station: Łódź Fabryczna, which will become part of a multimodal transport network, combining railway, long-distance bus, and car transportation as well as the city's public transport. The investment will also involve the reconstruction of the road system around the station, giving Łódź the opportunity to become a city with one of the best transport infrastructures in Poland.

Located at the very heart of Poland, the city holds many secrets and offers a plethora of attractions, such as:

THE NEW CENTRE OF ŁÓDŹ / OFF PIOTRKOWSKA / "MANUFAKTURA" MALL / "KSIĘŻY MŁYN" TEXTILE FACTORY / PIOTRKOWSKA STREET. One of the longest commercial streets in Eu-

rope, full of tenement houses, palaces, manufacturers' villas, churches, monuments of well-known local residents, and the headquarters of cultural institutions and companies of creative industries. /

POZNAŃSKI PALACE. The eclectic Izrael Poznański Palace is one of the largest manufacturers' residences in Poland. /

"DĘTKA" SEWER MUSEUM. Hidden under Plac Wolności (Freedom square), this constitutes a fragment of the 19th-century underground sewer network. /

ŁÓDZKIE MURALS. Large paintings which have already become an integral part of the city and changed its image. /

MUSEUM OF CINEMATOGRAPHY. This presents some impressive collections related to the history of cinematography. The museum holds one of the six Kaiserpanoramas built around 1900. /

VILLAS AND PALACES. There are around 200 villas and palaces of manufacturers. /

POST-INDUSTRIALISM. In Łódź there are around 300 post-factory facilities.

tódź is the heart of creative industry, clubbing, art events and festivals. The 19th-century traditions of an industrial and multi-cultural city continue to apply, and their result is continuous development. tódź features a landscape with the eclectic palaces of manufacturers, large murals, the experiences of four cultures, factory halls, chimneys, and ulica Piotrkowska – a vibrant street, one of the longest in Europe – which is the heart of cultural and film events.


ATLAS ARENA. One of the oldest sport and entertainment halls in Poland, where excellent volleyball and basketball matches and other events are held. /
